1998, Ralph Lerner covers Foxley v. Sotheby's Inc., SDNY 94 Civ. 7039 (SAS) in leading Art Law Treatise, "Art Law". In 1994, we filed an action on behalf of one of the country's largest collectors of Western art (and owner of at what was at one time, the country's largest cattle company) in a suit against Sotheby's, Inc. arising out of the fraudulent sale of art, a work attributed to Mary Cassett, in an amount in excess of \$650,000. The case was heavily litigated for two years and was also closely followed in the art and auction publications. Ralph Lerner, the leading scholar on Art Law, covered the case in his Treatise "Art Law" (2d Edition) starting in 1998, and continues to cover it through the latest edition, the Fifth Edition published in 2020. The case settled under seal but we can report the settlement favored our client.
